2016 True Story Rose of Pinot Noir Willamette Valley, Oregon

Fruit

100% Pinot Noir

Vineyards

Sourced from some of the highest vines in the Willamette Valley

Clones

Dijon 777, 114, 115

Vintage

A warm spring got 2016 off to an early start and for the second consecutive year we were picking grapes the first weeks of September. By the middle of the month the weather had cooled and led us into another great harvest. The conditions were perfect to make a bright complex rose.

Winemaking

A brief cold soak followed by a gentle press started the process. Gravity carried the wine to a stainless steel tank within the temperature regulated fermentation room. A slow controlled process resulted in a wine ready for bottling after four months.

Production: 75 Cases
ABV: 13.4%

Tasting Notes

Gorgeous vivid pink color, aromas of hood strawberries, a touch of rose water and a subtle minerality compose the nose. Crisp bright stone fruit dominates the palate with a hint of watermelon, while the constant undertone of strawberries continuous throughout the experience. Good complexity, possessing a power and grace that translates to a lively clean finish.
