Tasting Notes

The wine has a sparkling bright ruby red hue with a nose to match. A delicate bouquet of fresh red fruit is backed by a hint of spice and a light pleasant vanilla. The combination of marion berry and hood strawberry is balanced perfectly by the graceful acidity. The initial elegance evolves through the mouth and spreads across the mid-palete developing a long seductive finish. The rich velvety tannins create a fantastic texture that complete this complex balanced wine.
