

## 2015 True Story Rosé of Pinot Noir Willamette Valley, Oregon

Fruit 100% Pinot Noir

Vineyards Sourced from some of the oldest vines

in the Willamette

**Clones** Dijon 777, 114, 115

Vintage A dry mild winter lead to bud break a

few weeks earlier than usual. Even with a large fruit set the warm temperatures in the spring and summer brought an early harvest with ripe fruit. A cool down near harvest kept the acids in place and created a well-balanced and

bright rosé.

Harvest Date: 9/26/15

Winemaking A brief cold soak followed by a gentle

press started the process. Gravity carried the wine to the stainless steel tank within the temperature regulated fermentation room. A slow controlled process resulted in a wine ready for

bottling after four months.

Production: 75 Cases

ABV: 13.4%

Tasting Notes

Gorgeous pale pink color, aromas of hood strawberries, a touch of rose water and a subtle minerality compose the nose. Crisp bright stone fruit dominates the palate with a hint of watermelon, while the constant undertone of strawberries continuous throughout the experience. Good complexity, possessing a power and grace that translates to a lively clean finish.
